SIGN-UP: All applicants must be a member of a Crescent Ski Council affiliated club **at time of the trip** to participate. Applicant's membership will be verified by CSC. Everyone must sign-up directly with our travel agent, **Sports America Tours** (SAT) in Santa Rosa, CA. SAT will require a filled-out & **signed** application form to be confirmed onto the trip. Checks must be made payable to SAT.

SIGN-UP PERIOD: Sign-up period begins **June 15, 2009** and ends **November 16, 2009, or when 350 is reached**, whichever comes first. SAT will not accept any form of application for sign-up prior to, nor after this period.

PACKAGE COST(VARIES): **\$860 is the "base" rate in a 3B/3B unit**, which is limited in quantity (usually about 120 spaces). Other rates/options are available (see below).
