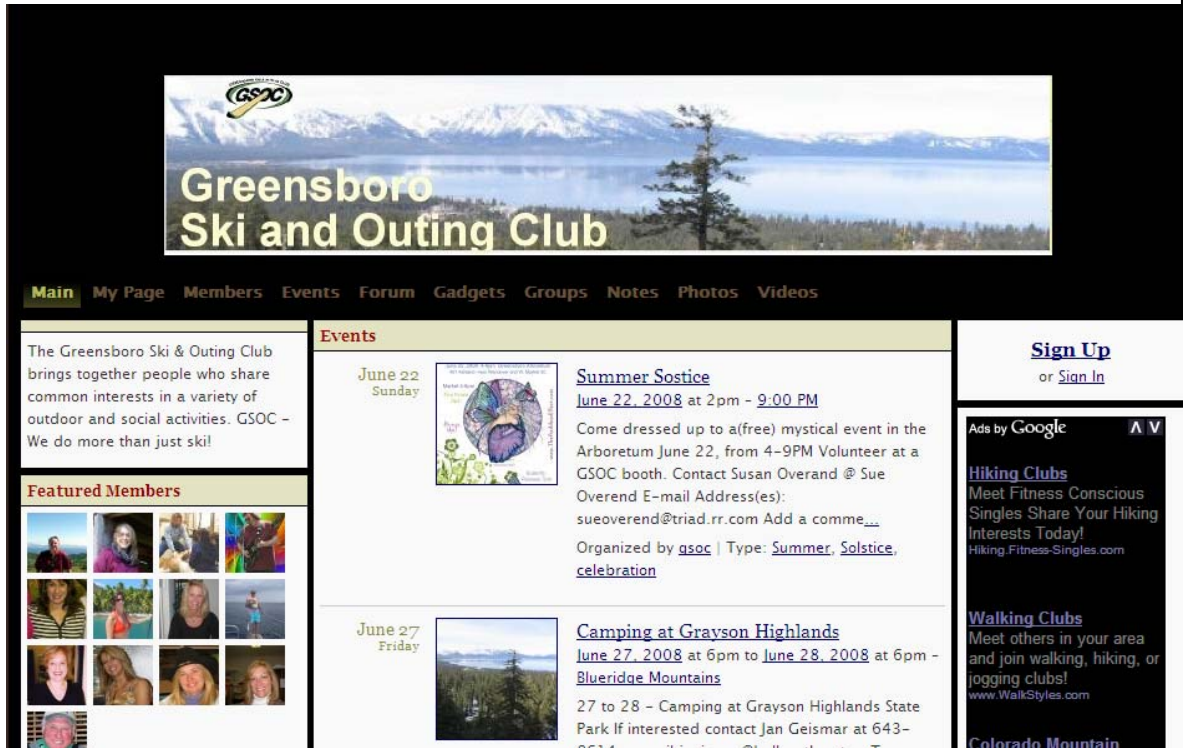


Haven't heard of the new "ning" site yet? Be sure to check it out!

The gsoskiandouting.ning.com site or "ning" for short was created as a means of getting more interaction from GSOC members and more information concerning various kinds of activities, whether these activities are planned by a community sponsor or by anyone who just wants to do something and invite other members to join in.

Examples are to meet at a local establishment for conversation and refreshment, or an outdoor activity such as a bike ride in the park, or tennis on the weekend, or a local day trip. Not all GSOC activities need be a long excursion or consume a sum of money from your savings account.



This site gives you an opportunity to share photos, experience, and discussions concerning activities or topics of interest that you can start yourself.

Make the GSOC membership a community experience. But you have to Join Us in the brown area on the right side of the page and you must be a GSOC member to join "ning". Non-members can see most of the site but cannot interact with it. We invite non-members to become a member of the GSOC, and then join the "ning" activities site. You can go directly to www.gsoskiandouting.ning.com or from the original site www.greensboroskiandoutingclub.org and hit the link to **Photos/Forum** on the left or "**NING**" link on the bottom of page. To participate on the site follow the steps "to add" an Event, Forum, Discussion etc and don't forget to save before moving off the page. It may ask you to submit some extra info, or photo to complete the task in order to save it and to be posted. There is a feature button if you wish to put on the main page. And don't forget to save it. Don't worry you won't mess the web site up and if you make an error you can either edit or delete your info and start over with your correction. We have all done that once or twice at least.

DAN RIVER TUBING TRIP SATURDAY AUGUST 2

Spend the day on the refreshing Dan River near Hanging Rock State Park. We will meet in the Wal-Mart parking lot on Battleground Ave. at 8:45 AM. We will depart sharply at 9:00. The cost will be \$9 per tube. We will collect your tube money before we leave. Make checks payable to Danbury General Store.

Directions: Take 220 north to 158 and turn left towards Belews Lake. Follow 158 into Stokesdale where it merges with 65. Follow 65 to 311 which is immediately past the railroad tracks. Turn right & follow 311 thru Walnut Cove until 311 & 89 split. Stay left & follow 89 about 3 miles past Danbury. The Danbury General Store is on the right immediately past the Route 8 bridge over the Dan River. Park at the General Store (593-8780) on to the right.

Consumption of beer around the store is not permitted and is monitored by the local police. The trip will last about 3 hours. We recommend renting one tube for your cooler. You are allowed to bring beer on the river. **Please respect the beauty of the area & do not litter!!!!** We will be taken by truck to the drop off spot where our tubes already have been placed. Please wait for everyone to arrive before going on the river. At the end, only get out of the river on your right side at Danbury General Store because it is illegal to bring alcoholic beverages into the park on the left side. We recommend bringing a picnic lunch, cooler, refreshments, a change of clothes, sun screen & rope to tie the tubes together. There is a place to change & shower at the store. Enjoy yourselves!

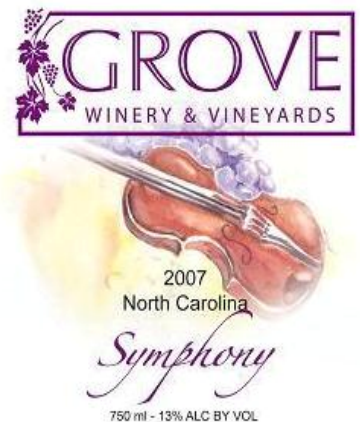
